**Disaster Kit** - Check stock quarterly. Take if evacuation is necessary. Include items you might want to take to an evacuation shelter. Remember to include medications and glasses.

**Stay Informed** - Maintain access to NOAA or local radio, TV, email or text alerts for important and current information about disasters.

**Financial Information** – I.D.s, Social Sec card, copies of bank statements, cash, utility bills as proof of residence in applying for assistance.

**Maintaining Plan** - Share the completed plan with those who need to know. Meet with household members every 3-4 months or as needs change to update household plan.
